We've worked hard to curate this season around all the uncertainty of these times, and you'll notice a few things that are a little different as a result. But for all the difficulties of this period, there are also some emerging triumphs. Artists are a resilient bunch, and many have used this time to create and develop extraordinary new work. Our Season features the first wave of some of this great new theatre, like Drew Fairley's devastatingly funny and personal *As Luck Would Have It*, inspired by being stuck on a cruise ship in the early days of the pandemic; and the extraordinary sound and light installation *Blindness*, from London's legendary Donmar Warehouse, their creative response to safely re-engaging audiences as theatres began to reopen there; and with the phrase "open-air theatre" never sounding more inviting, we begin what we hope to make an annual tradition - our first Shakespeare in the Garden offers a summer evening of theatre under the stars, with *A Midsummer Night's Dream* in the magical Wollongong Botanic Garden.

One of the unexpected blessings of these difficult times has been Merrigong's ability (through additional funding and the incredible generosity of our donors) to provide even greater support to artists making new work. So while we may not have been able to invite you to see it, our MERRIGONGX Artists' Program has been in full swing, with artists developing work behind closed doors. Much of that work is now ready for an audience, so you'll notice that this year we have more Merrigong-produced work than ever in the Mainstage Season, and for the first time, Season Ticket Holders can include shows from our MERRIGONGX Season in their Season Ticket packages. With our commitment to the independent artists whose shows were cancelled last year, as well as some fantastic new projects, there are seven incredible new works to choose from in our MERRIGONGX offering.

We start with a bang, when (thanks to Federal Government RISE funding) Spiegeltent Wollongong returns in March, and we open both the Merrigong Season and the Spiegeltent with *Circa's Peepshow*.

Just a little gig to pay the bills, maybe decompress a little, dust off his Hawaiian shirts, cuddle a few martinis, that kind of thing. The next day, a worldwide pandemic is declared. The ship is exiled into the middle of the Pacific Ocean with nothing but empty ballrooms for him to crack his jokes in. Trapped on the empty liner, he longs to escape, but the ocean has other plans...

Commissioned by Merrigong, *As Luck Would Have It* is inspired by playwright and actor Drew Fairley's experiences being marooned on a cruise ship during the early months of the pandemic. It's the odyssey of a man drumming up mirth while he grips onto the edge of a funnel that threatens to plunge him into the abyss. With songs!

In turns hilarious and devastating, this extraordinary new work leans into the absurdity of survival whilst sliding to the edge of reason.
